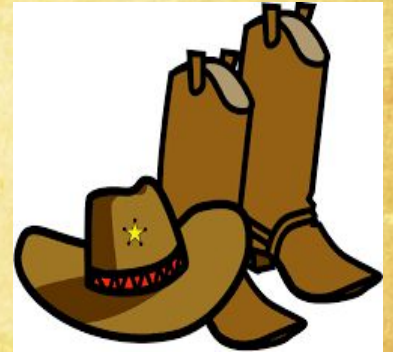

Health at School

When to keep your child home

- Temperature of 100.4
 - Vomiting and/or diarrhea
 - Undiagnosed rash
 - Unusually red eyes with drainage (not allergy related)

Medication at School

- Requires doctor's order/parent consent form
- Should be dropped off by parent to front office
- Must be in original container with pharmacy label
- Kept in a locked cabinet in the health office



Immunizations



- Students must be fully immunized before entering kindergarten
 - You must show proof of immunization when registering your child
 - Exceptions include a permanent medical exemption or a temporary medical exemption-Updates to requirements January 1, 2021

Kindergarten Immunization Requirements

Polio

4 Doses

3 doses ok if one dose was given on or after fourth birthday

DTAP

5 Doses

4 doses ok if one dose was given on or after fourth birthday

MMR

2 Doses

Must be given on or after first birthday

Hep. B

3 Doses

Varicella

2 Doses

Immunization Law Change for 2021-22 School Year

- Beginning January 1, 2021, doctors will use an electronic form available through the California Immunization Registry (CAIR). CAIR is a secure computer system that is already used across California that stores children's immunization (shot) records. The doctor can send the form to the child's parent or school, or the school can access the form through CAIR directly. Schools can only accept medical exemptions on the CAIR form. If you have questions or concerns about CAIR's system or forms, please contact your District Nurse.

Hearing and Vision



- Students will have their hearing and vision screened in kindergarten
 - This a state mandated requirement
 - Subsequent screenings are done in 2nd, 5th and 8th grade

Attendance

REGISTRATION:

- Registration is on-line
- Go to the **District** or **School Website** to complete the online registration
- Come to the school office and bring with you the following:
 - TWO PROOFS OF RESIDENCY** (current mortgage or lease, and a current utility bill)
 - BIRTH CERTIFICATE** (Student must be 5 on or before September 1st 2021)
 - IMMUNIZATION RECORDS** (must be up-to-date)
- A registration packet will be provided with 4 additional forms for parents to fill out
- Report of Health Examination for School Entry is a State law requirement for first grade. The physical exam can be obtained as early as 6 months before entering kindergarten to as late as 3 months after first grade entry.

NOTE: PACKETS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED IF ALL OF THE REQUIREMENTS ARE MET AND THE PACKET IS COMPLETE.

Attendance

SCHOOL OF CHOICE: *(for those outside our boundaries)*

- ***School of Choice applications*** will be accepted from **February 1st - March 5th , 2021**
- A parent or guardian must complete the SOC application
- You will need your child's **seven digit student ID number**
- For students new to the District you can ask for the ID number from the school of residence after you fully register at your child
- When you apply for SOC and are approved you are agreeing to give up your child's seat at their home school
- **Approval and denial notification e-mail** will be sent first week of May
- **If approved**, student must attend his/her school of choice **one full year**
- **Transportation** to any school other than the home school **is the responsibility of the parents**
